OUR RESPONSE to COVID-19 (Fall 2020)

(from Skate Canada BC/YK Return to Play for Figure Skating Guidelines COVID Policy and Protocols)

SAFTEY OFFICERS

Parent volunteers:

Safety Officers are required at each session as per SkateCanada. This is a simple job that will give the facility assurance that we are following The City of Surrey protocol as well as Skate Canada Guidelines for returning to skating.

You will be assigned a session that your child is on to be the safety officer. Hopefully each parent will only need to do this once in the initial 5-week period.

Skaters need to be at the arena and lined up outside 15 min prior to the session. As skaters arrive, the safely officer will complete the “session record” (attached)

What you need:

A facemask

Gloves (winter gloves are fine)

A pen (that only will use)

A blank session record

(our online registration system will give us a list of all registered skaters for each session – which will be sent to you so you know who to expect)

A copy of skater’s waivers will be submitted to the rink on the first day.

Once all skaters are checked in a City of Surrey employee will escort them to a change room, as a group. Skaters must not be late – 15 min prior to session start time is mandatory to allow for the City of Surrey Covid-19 Protocol.

Skaters will have 10 min in the change room to get ready for their session.

The safety office can go in to the rink **IF they are with in the 20 people** maximum allowed by the facility.

If you do not show up for you Safety office shift, you risk the session being canceled for all skaters.

If you do not arrive prior to the group going in to the facility, you will not be permitted in as per the City of Surrey

With a little bit of team work, we can have successful start up to our 2020-21 season.

*I will be at the 1st sessions and will be the Safety Officer for those sessions. Please take this time to learn how the City wants us to follow their protocols, so that when it is your turn, you will know.
